- Ensure Observing, assessing and summarising each child's progress and achievements- this is to tailor learning opportunities to cater for each child. Ensure all children's Individual Development Maps, reports, assessments and documentation are current and provide clear and accurate actions/interventions/development to progress children through the stages of the Curriculum.
- Ensure equality, inclusion, diversity and international values are at the heart of all interactions and relationships with children and their families and that those values take into account any multilingualism, multi-culturalism and children's health or disability requirements.
- Remain abreast with childcare and educational current strategies/policies and practices which recognises and promotes best practice across the Early Years Sector and ensure these opportunities are integrated within the Setting.
- Establish positive partnerships with Parents/Carers to ensure each child's individual needs are understood, to include the children's interest and invaluable insights that parents can provide and that this information is used to set high expectations which are reflected through every stage of the children's Preschool development.
